Classes: *Based on the regulations of the Czech Kennel Club (ČMKU).*
Baby class – 4 to 6 months of age
Puppy class – 6 to 9 months of age
Junior class – 9 to 18 months of age
Intermediate class – 15 to 24 months of age
Open class – 15 months and older
Working class – 15 months and older, with a valid working certificate
Winners class – 15 months and older, with a valid national or international champion title, European winner, World winner, Club winner and Specialty winner titles (gained in adult classes)
Veterans class – 8 years and older
Honour class – with a valid national or international champion title, European winner, World winner, Club winner and Specialty winner titles. A grade and placement are awarded. The winner of the class does not proceed to any further competition.

Other classes: **Best brace** – dog and bitch of the same owner presented at the show
Best breeder's group – at least 3 and a maximum of 5 dogs, who have been presented at the show, sired by at least two different sires or out of two different dams. These dogs do not have to be owned by the same owner.
Best progeny group (sire or dam) – a sire or dam is entered with at least 5 offspring (first generation). The sire or dam do not have to be judged at the show.
Child and Beagle – child aged 3–8 years
Junior Handling – child aged 9–14 years.

Titles: *Dogs will be judged under regulations of the Czech Kennel Club (ČMKU).*
CAJC – may be awarded to the dog and bitch winners from the junior class graded as “excellent 1”.
CAC – may be awarded to dogs and bitches, winners of intermediate, open, working and champion classes graded as “excellent 1”.
res. CAC – may be awarded to dogs and bitches, winners of intermediate, open, working and champion classes graded as “excellent 2”, if the title CAC was awarded in the class.
Specialty Winner – CAC winners from the intermediate, open, working and champion class compete for the title.
Best Junior of Breed (BOJ) – both dog and bitch CAJC winners compete for the title.
Best Veteran of Breed (BOV) – both dog and bitch veteran winners, graded as “excellent 1” compete for the title.

Best of Breed (BOB) – both CAJC winners (dog and bitch), Specialty winner male and female and Specialty veteran winners male and female compete for the title.

Best of Opposite Sex (BOS) – the CAJC winner, Best male or female and veteran winner of the opposite sex than the selected BOB winner compete for the title.

The following titles are unofficial:

Specialty Baby Winner – may be awarded to the dog and bitch winners from the baby class graded as “very promising 1”.

Specialty Puppy Winner – may be awarded to the dog and bitch winners from the puppy class graded as “very promising 1”.

Specialty Junior Winner – may be awarded to the dog and bitch winners from the junior class awarded with the title CAJC.

Specialty Veteran Winner – may be awarded to the dog and bitch winners from the veteran class graded as “very promising 1”.

Best Baby in Show – both dog and bitch Specialty Baby Winners compete for the title.

Best Puppy in Show – both dog and bitch Specialty Puppy Winners compete for the title.

Best Working Beagle – both the dog and bitch awarded with the title CAC from working class compete for the title (both the dog and bitch must compete, if the CAC title was not awarded, the working title will not be awarded).

Best non-tri – competition for the best non-tricolour entry (i.e. all apart from tricolour, blue tricolour and tricolour mottle). The competition is invitational based on the judge’s decision.

Veterinary conditions:

By veterinary check the dog’s health certificate or passport must be shown with proof of valid rabies vaccinations.

General rules and regulations:

The show is open to all Beagles registered in FCI kennel clubs who have reached the necessary age at least at the day of the show. Imported dogs must be registered in national stud books. The organizer of the show is not responsible for damage caused by the dog or the exhibitor, for death or loss of the dog. Dogs must remain on leashes. Bitches in heat are excluded; as are pregnant bitches and lactating bitches and dogs which have been operated on to improve conformation. Bringing puppies to the show for the purpose of their sale is forbidden. If the show is cancelled for general reasons, entry fees will be used for payments for the show costs.

Fill in a separate form for each dog! A copy of the FCI pedigree, the recognized Champion title for Champion class and an International working certificate for Working class must be included! All Entry forms to Working class or Winner class without FCI-Working certificate or without confirmed champion title will be automatically transferred to Open class.

The entry of the dog will be confirmed 5 days before the show by e-mail.

The organizer is not responsible for incorrectly filled entry forms.
